Chureito Pagoda & Mt Fuji 忠霊塔・富士山

Pagoda view of Mt Fuji • Yamanashi (Shimo-Yoshida Stn) • Free Japan's most iconic Fuji view

A five-story pagoda at Arakura Sengen Shrine framing Mt Fuji with cherry blossoms — arguably Japan's most photographed view.

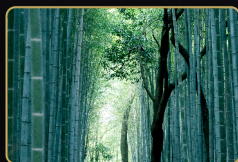


Shibuya Sky 渋谷スカイ

Open-air rooftop deck • Tokyo (Shibuya Stn) • ¥3,000+ Tokyo's premier 360° view

A 230m open-air rooftop above the world's busiest crossing — sweeping sunset panoramas, Mt Fuji on clear days.

Arashiyama Bamboo Grove 嵐山竹林

Towering bamboo path • Kyoto (Saga-Arashiyama Stn) • Free Kyoto's signature landmark

A serene path through soaring bamboo on Kyoto's west edge, filtered green light and rustling leaves overhead.

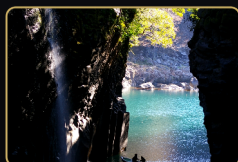


Hitachi Seaside Park 国営ひたち海浜公園

Vast seaside flower park • Ibaraki (Katsuta Stn + bus) • ¥450+ World-famous nemophila & kochia

Late spring: a sea of 5M+ sky-blue nemophila on Miharashi Hill; autumn: the same hills blaze crimson with kochia.

Takachiho Gorge 高千穂峽

Volcanic river gorge • Miyazaki, Kyushu (bus to Takachiho) • Free (boat ~¥5,000)
National Place of Scenic Beauty

Sheer basalt columns where Manai Falls plunges into emerald water — best seen by rowboat beneath the cliffs.
