Sukiyaabashi Jiro すきやばし次郎

Edomae omakase, ultra high-end • Ginza (by Ginza Stn) • ¥¥¥ Former 3★ (no public booking)

The ~10-seat counter of Jiro Ono, the 'god of sushi' made famous by Jiro Dreams of Sushi.

Sushi Saito 鮨さいとう

Edomae omakase, ultra high-end • Roppongi (Ark Hills South Tower) • ¥¥¥ (invitation-only) Former 3★

Rated among the world's very best; Takashi Saito's intimate counter is near-impossible to book.

Manten Sushi まんてん鮨

Edomae omakase, best value • Marunouchi (by Tokyo Stn) • ¥¥ Acclaimed value omakase

A chef's omakase that brings counter-grade sushi without the months-long wait of the three-star giants.

Sushi Dai 寿司大

Market breakfast omakase • Toyosu Market (Shijo-mae Stn) • ¥¥ Toyosu's famous market sushi

Toyosu's most famous market sushi; the dawn omakase draws hours-long queues from early morning.

High-speed touch-panel sushi • Shibuya Dogenzaka • ¥

Genki Sushi's playful 'rocket' sushi — order on a tablet, plates zoom to your seat from ~¥120.

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
